1994 FORD SVT MUSTANG COBRA

In 1994, SVT continued its primary mission: to provide driving entertainment for a select group of discriminating drivers. Central to the Cobra's exceptional performance is a potent 5.0L V-8, which has undergone substantial modification to give it 25 more horsepower than the standard 5.0L. Particular attention was paid to improving the engine's breathing characteristics, including modifications to the cylinder heads, roller rockers, valve springs and upper intake manifold. Calibrations followed to improve handling, ride and braking, including the addition of 17"x8" wheels and 13" brakes. The body change was also significant, introducing an all-new look with a new interpretation of the classic Mustang profile. The interior changed as well, with a revised, driver-oriented interior with a "twin-cockpit" design and white-faced gauges.

The 1994 Cobra was selected as Official Pace Car for the Indianapolis 500.
